Local MP Greg Hands and Councillors from RBKC, Westminster and Hammersmith will be on hand to respond to the case put forward by The King's Road Association of Chelsea Residents, the Belgravia Residents Association, the Knightsbridge Association and the Ladbroke Association, and other central London residents. Our elected representatives will be suggesting ways of controlling the rash of basement developments.

Works for extending under existing houses are not like ordinary building works because they take much longer, cause much greater noise and vibration, greater disruption to traffic and parking, often endanger neighbouring properties and make neighbouring properties temporarily uninhabitable.

If you have been affected or if you are concerned by the possibility of subterranean development happening near you, we urge you to come. Remember that just because you live in a house which already has a basement this still concerns you as some people want to develop a basement under a basement!

After our last meeting we have some proposals and want to work with our councils to improve control over these developments to contain the nuisance this causes to us as residents. Local Councillors from RBKC and MP's will be present.
